

## Cash Dividends Distribution for the Year ended 2022 for Shareholders of Medicare Group(Q.P.S.C.)

Medicare Group (Q.P.S.C.) is pleased to announce that its AGM held on March 29, 2023 has approved the distribution of cash dividends to its shareholders for the financial year ended on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022 of 26.25 % of nominal share value (i.e. QR 0.2625 per share).

Eligibility shall be for shareholders as of close of business trading hours at Qatar Stock Exchange (QSE) on Wednesday, March 29, 2023 in accordance with the shareholders list provided by Qatar Central Securities Depository (QCSD).

Shareholders may obtain their dividends as of Sunday, April 2, 2023 through QNB as per to the following mechanism.

- QNB shall automatically transfer shareholders' dividends to their bank account details registered with QCSD or with QNB.
- Shareholders who do not have registered bank account at (QCSD) or with QNB; may receive their dividends by filling out and signing the form (Application for Dividends Credit to the Account) and send it along with the necessary supporting documents by e-mail: [easydividend@qnb.com.qa](mailto:easydividend@qnb.com.qa) or handing over to any QNB branch. Accordingly, QNB will transfer the dividends to the shareholder's bank account. No dividend will be paid by cash.
